- Parents will send snack, lunch and drink. Parents will have the opportunity to purchase white or chocolate milk for their children.
- Kindergarteners will eat in the cafeteria and will be given the opportunity to purchase Pizza and ice cream on Wednesdays starting in October.
- Drop off in am will be out back in regular car lines- starting at 8:45am. or students will enter by main foyer after being dropped off by the bus
- Please do not walk your child into school on the first day
- You and your kindergartener can drop off school supplies with your child's name on them on Wednesday, August 26th between 1-2:00pm.
- Parent pick up at the end of the day- students will be brought out the back doors by the teachers immediately following prayer or students will take the bus home
- Students will attend Mass bi monthly and prayer services that school has- Parents are always welcome and encouraged to join us!
- Kindergarten students will have 8th grade buddies
- Kindergarten students will participate in school service journal- more details to follow
- Kindergarten students will participate in Guided Meditations
- Parent volunteers in the classroom, at lunch time and on field trips need to be STAND trained. It is recommended that all our parents start the process over the summer by doing the initial training. Visit the website <http://www.archbalt.org/STAND/training.cfm>
- Lunch volunteers are always needed to help the teachers monitor the playground area- need to be STAND trained
- All families are required to do 30 hours of volunteer service during the year. All volunteer time should be logged in the binder in the front school office.
- There are many food allergies. There will be one activity per month using food- teachers will make you aware of the activity beforehand.
- We have a healthy school's initiative this past year- we do not use food to celebrate student birthday's. Students are called to the office to receive a pin (sheep for girls and shepherds crook for boys)- and will be blessed by the teacher and the class on their birthdays. We do recognize summer birthdays at the end of the school year.
